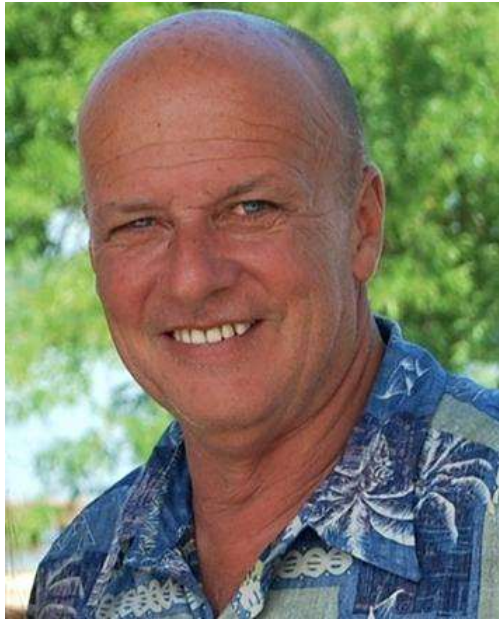


## Patrick Pratt (1955-2018)



Patrick Lee Pratt, 63, of Honolulu, Hawaii, died at 9:27 PM HST on Friday, November 9, 2018, at Straub Hospital, Honolulu, Hawaii.

Born October 19, 1955, in Burlington, Iowa, Pat was the son of the late Thomas E. Pratt and the late Katherine Hoffman Newton. On February 9, 1999, he married Yang Soon Kim of Honolulu.
